## Church Etiquette

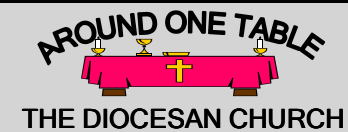
- **Appropriate attire for Mass:** From Fr. Rick: I know that for many this topic is unpopular but I feel it needs to be talked about. The topic is the proper attire for wear to Mass. We live in a casual society and it becomes even more casual during the summer months. There is nothing casual about the Sacred Mass. We literally stand before the throne of God and through Christ offer ourselves to God the Father. This sacred action demands the utmost respect and preparation. What we wear to Mass reflects greatly on our understanding and reverence for this great mystery. I ask that you think about this as you choose your attire and your children's attire for Mass. **Short, cutoffs, Bermuda shorts, etc are never appropriate. Tank tops, sleeveless shirts and clothing that are less than modest are not appropriate.** Remember what it is that you are doing at Mass. If you were to see me approach the altar to preside at Mass dressed in blue jeans and a tee shirt, you would be appalled, and I am sure that more than one of you would be on the phone to the bishop (and rightly so!) The proper attire for Mass is equally important for you as is for the priest.
