Consider Liturgy: The comments of Duffy and Baldwin are an echo of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "The word 'liturgy' originally meant a 'public work' or a 'service in the name of / on behalf of the people.' In Christian tradition it means the participation of the People of God in 'the work of God.' Through the liturgy Christ, our redeemer and high priest, continues the work of our redemption in, with, and through his Church." (CCC 1069) "Given the fact that so much of postindustrial society is consumer oriented, it is only natural that many (if not most) people have come to expect 'what they want' out of liturgy." (Baldwin) This is not necessarily the same as what God wants or intends to give us. May God bless you. +Bishop Vasa

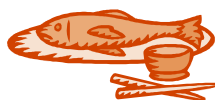
