- **Offertory year end statements:** You should have received your Year End statement in the mail this past week. If you did not receive a statement you may not be registered with the Parish. Please call Julie in the office with any questions regarding your statements. Thank you.
 - **Mass intentions:** There are many days available now for special mass intentions. If you would like to have a mass said for a special intention please contact the office. The stipend set by the diocese for a mass intention is \$10.00, but any stipend is ok, or no stipend at all. Masses may not be scheduled for the Sunday Mass, since the intention for this Mass is pro populo (for the people of the parish). Only one special mass intention per day is allowed.
 - **Are you Divorced? Remarried outside of the Church?** Have you ever considered seeking an annulment? The Annulment process looks at your previous marriage to see if there was something essential to the Sacrament of Marriage that may have been missing at the time you exchanged vows. If there was an essential part of marriage missing at the time you exchanged vows, the church could declare the previous marriage null, because the "Sacrament" never existed. If you would like to explore the possibility of an annulment, please contact Fr. Rick or Deacon Jim and they will help you through the process. Not all marriages are invalid and not all marriages can be declared null, but isn't it worth it finding out?
