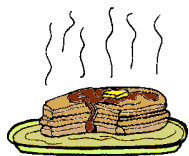

Consider Liturgy: Once again we turn to the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "As the work of Christ liturgy is also an action of his *Church*. It makes the Church present and manifests her as the visible sign of the communion in Christ between God and men. It engages the faithful in the new life of the community and involves the "conscious, active, and fruitful participation" of everyone. (CCC 1071)" This emphasis on the liturgy as the "work of Christ" is repeated numerous times in the Catechism. A similar theme is also found: "The liturgy is also a participation in Christ's own prayer addressed to the Father in the Holy Spirit. In the liturgy, all Christian prayer finds its source and goal." (CCC 1073) May God bless you.

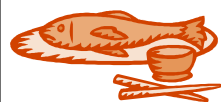
St. Faustina's Friendship Coffee
